

keeping Ordinary <sup>Deputy Sheriff</sup> Justice of the peace atty's deputy Com<sup>r</sup> of  
 the Sheriff, or had any other public office whatsoever for any County  
 within this province. And be it further enacted by the  
 Authority afo<sup>r</sup> that if any Ordinary keep shall keep Court in his  
 house upon complaint made thereof to the Justice of the County Court of  
 such Ordinary his behaviour or keeping Court in his house the said  
 Justice of the County Courts are hereby authorized and Impowered to suppress  
 such Ordinary keep and Call in such License. And be it further

enacted by the Authority afo<sup>r</sup> that any Ordinary keep disabled or suppressed  
 as afo<sup>r</sup> shall pay for the same <sup>the sum of</sup> two thousand pounds of tobacco and so proportionally  
 for a longer or shorter time that any person shall sell Liquors or do  
 contrary to this Law one half to his Lordship his heirs and successors  
 for y<sup>e</sup> use afo<sup>r</sup> and the other half to him or them that shall sue for y<sup>e</sup>  
 same to be recovered in any Court of record within this province by bill plaint  
 or Information wherein no Escoyned protection or Wager of Law to be allowed

And be it further enacted by the Authority afo<sup>r</sup> that no person  
 or persons Inhabiting within this province not having Lawfull License  
 shall sell by retail unless sold at y<sup>e</sup> Common and usuall Rates of such  
 Liquors between Merchants and others any Cyder <sup>Drinks</sup> Junco, or other Strong  
 Liquors to be drunk in his her or their House or about his her or their plan-  
 tation upon forfeiture of Every time he she or they shall be Legally Con-  
 vict thereof the Sum of one thousand pounds of tobacco one half thereof  
 to his Lordship his heirs and Successors for y<sup>e</sup> use afo<sup>r</sup> and y<sup>e</sup> other half to y<sup>e</sup>  
 Informer or to him or them that shall sue for y<sup>e</sup> same to be recovered as afo<sup>r</sup>

And whereas it hath been found prejudicial to the Inhabitants of  
 this province that Ordinary keep<sup>r</sup> & Inholders have frequently entertained  
 divers froward and Loose persons a great time tipling at their houses  
 as well to y<sup>e</sup> great Damage of many persons as their own Ruine  
 Be it therefore enacted by the Authority afo<sup>r</sup> by and with y<sup>e</sup> Advice  
 and Consent afo<sup>r</sup> that it shall not be Lawfull for any such Ordinary  
 keep<sup>r</sup> or Inholder to keep such Ordinary or house of Entertainments  
 until they have Entred into recognizance before y<sup>e</sup> Justice of Each respec-  
 tive County Granting such License with Two sufficient Sureties to  
 the Value of twenty pounds Sterl that they shall not entertain any froward or  
 Loose person in their house above twenty four hours (four times
