

Two & Filings and Six pence Carrancy yearly and no more for the
granting - Such permits as aforesaid and shall give good security to be
taken by such Officer aforesaid or their Deputy or Deputies in his Majesty's
name that he and they shall and will duly observe the Acts of Trade
and Navigation and Other Good Laws of this Province relating thereto

And be it further Enacted that all and every Collector and
Deputies of this Province shall have and receive such fees for entering
clearing such Ships and Vessels aforesaid as are above allowed to
the Customs Officers and no more and that all Collectors and Customs
Officers shall make a schedule of their fees and hang up in their Office
under the penalty of fifty pounds Sterling to his Majesty his heirs and
Successors for the Support of Government to be recovered in any Court of Record
within this Province by action of debt bill plaint or information which no
warrant protection or wager of Law to be allowed

PROVIDED always that in case any person shall refuse to pay the
sums by this Act limited and allowed it shall be lawful for the
Chancellor Secretary Judge for probate of Wills &c. Surveyor or General
or his Deputies Sheriff Coroner Clerk of the Council Clerk of the Court of
Appeals the Several Clerks of the County Courts, Cryer of the Provincials
and the Several Cryers of the County Courts to recover the same by
way of Execution against the Goods Tobacco or Chattels of the person or
persons defaulting and no other

PROVIDED always that such person or persons
having no tobacco and that shall refuse to show unto such Officer
or Officers as shall collect the same such Goods and Chattels shall
be liable for or Officers to take the body or bodies of such person or
persons in Execution for the same

PROVIDED also that no Officer or Officers
in this Act particularly mentioned and whose fees are hereby set
and limited shall by virtue thereof either have or cause to be levied
any Execution upon the Body Goods or Chattels of any person or persons
whatsoever for any fees limited and contained without believing
or causing to be delivered a true and just account of the fees to be due
by this Act as aforesaid under the hand or hands of such Officer or Officers
to the person or persons to whom such fees demanded are due in
aforesaid thirty days at the least before Execution levied, and in case
any of the said Officer or Officers as aforesaid shall in anywise do or
contrary ~~do~~ or in Directly to this Act he or they so offending shall
lose and forfeit to the party grieved double Damages sustained and shall
