A Sessions of Assembly begun and held at the City of Annapolis in the County of Annapurnde ll the Eighteen Day of July in the Sixth Year of the Dominion of the Right Honourable Charles absolute Lord & Proprietary of the provinces of Maryland and Avalon Lord Baron of Baltimore &c. Annoq Domini: Seventeen hundred and twenty one. His Honour Charles Calvert Esq being Governour.

Were Enacted the Laws following (viz)

An Act for Reviving of an Act Entituled an Act for raising a Duty of three pence per Hogshead on all Tobacco Exported out of this province for the uses therein Mentioned.

Be it Enacted by the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary by and with the Advice and Consent of his Lordships Governour and the upper and Lower Houses of Assembly and the Authority of the Same that an Act made at a Session of Assembly begun and held at the City of Annapolis the Eleventh Day of October last Entituled an Act for raising a Duty of three pence per Hogshead on all Tobaccos Exported out of this province for the use therein mentioned be and is hereby revived and continued to be in full force from the twenty Ninth Day of September next ^{and remains} untill the twenty Ninth Day of September that shall happen in the Year of our Lord one thousand Seven hundred and twenty three.
