

(548) Such his or their Oath or Oaths or taking such Test aforesaid be
 Convict of Willfull and corrupt perjury thereupon or of a willfull
 Breach or Noncompliance with the tenore of such Test that the
 the Said Robert Lewis, Andrew Castle, and Gilbert Rowleson
 George Lexton and John Robinson or such or so many of them
 as shall be convict as aforesaid shall upon such Conviction be
 adjudged to Stand two Hours in the Pillory and have his or
 their Left Ear or Ears cut off and shall be wholly deprived of
 any Benefitts designed them or either of them by this Law and
 shall be from thenceforth Lyable to be prosecuted for any
 Debts or Demands whatsoever in the Same Manner as if
 this Act had never been made any ^{thing} therein contained to the
 Contrary Notwithstanding.
