Be it Enacted by the Rt Honble the Lord Proprietor by and with the Advice and Consent of his Lordship's Governour and the Upper & Lower houses of Assembly of this Province and the Authority of the Same that from and after the ~~15th~~ Last Day of November next it shall not be Lawfull for any Justice or Justices of the Peace within any of the severall Countys within this Province to Whome any Wolves head shall be brought and Application made by any person or persons whatsoever for a Certificate thereof to Intitle him or them to the Allowance according to the aforesd Act in the County Secoy unless he or they Doe first Declare upon their Corporall Oath to be Administred by such Justice or Justices so Sworn to or affirmation by the People called Quakers that such Wolf or Wolves wherof these are the Heads were Actually Killed in that County where they pray for such Allowance, And Further that no Certificate in Order to be Allowed in Any the severall Countys within this Province shall be Given by any of the Justices afo for any Wolves head or heads that shall be brought before them by any Judican or that has been bought of any Judican by any person ~~whom~~ whatsoever unless such Wolves head or heads are brought before such Justices or Justices whole and Entire and that they Appear to such Justice to be Green and fresh Killed any thing in the aforesaid Acts or any Other Statutes Law or Customs to the contrary Notwithstanding
