

Other Lands in the County of Somerset Queen Anne's & Talbot Fisheries
 the said Airdredon pretended to have Right in Order to secure them for being
 bound unto the said Birmingham for the sum One hundred and fifty pounds
 wth Interest on the behalf of the said Airdredon wth the said Airdredon to be paid
 on the said Airdredon Paying unto the said Birmingham the s^{um} Sum
 of One hundred and fifty pounds with the Interest thereof on the s^{ix} Sixteenth
 Day of July 1674 ~~the~~ hundred and Twenty Three, and Whereas also that
 the said Gandvitt and Head by their said petition did further set forth that
 the said Airdredon hath not only neglected according the said Deed of Sale and
 the said of the said Lands conveyed to him by the said Birmingham, but also
 refused to Acknowledge the Deed of bargain & Sale made by him to the s^{aid} Gandvitt
 and Head according to Laws of this Province and that the said Airdredon
 hath privately wth drawn himself unto parts beyond the seas without paying
 the said Birmingham the sum One hundred and fifty pounds wth the Interest
 thereof or paying or securing the Payment of the said several Sums of Money
 unto the s^{aid} Gandvitt and Head for which they stand engaged on behalf of the
 said Airdredon, and therefore humbly pray that they may be relieved in the
 premises by this generall Assembly and that an act might pass to settle and
 Justice from the said Gandvitt and Head and their Heirs and Assignes in the said
 Lands in Bohemia Manner on their proof of the allegations aforesaid and
 how far as much as the said Gandvitt and Head have fully proved the same allegations
 Be it Enacted by the ^{therefore} Honorable the Lord Proprietor and with the Advice
 and Consent of his Lordships Governour and the Upper and Lower houses of
 Assembly of this Province and the Authority of the Same, that from & after
 the End of this present Session of Assembly the said Fran: Gandvitt & Head
 shall stand and be seized of ^{an} absolute Estate of Inheritance in fee Simple to
 them their Heirs and Assignes for Ever of and in the said Lands and Premises
 in Bohemia Manner ^{and} only in as full and ample a Manner as if the said
 Deed from the said Birmingham to the said Airdredon unto the said Gandvitt
 and Head had been duly Acknowledged and recorded pursuant to the Act of
 Assembly of this Province in that Case made and provided any Law or Statute
 to the contrary Notwithstanding, Provided also and it is here by
 Enacted and Declared by the Authority Advice and Consent aforesaid that if in
 Case the said Fran: Gandvitt & Head or any of them shall die or assigne
 shall or doe satisfy and pay unto the said Rich: Birmingham his Heirs
