year Seventeen hundred and Twenty Six

Whereas This present Generall Assembly have for
Defraying the publick Charge of This province to the
Twenty Third day of July Instant raised a certain
sum of Tobacco and money amounting to two hundred
and sixty six Thousand & thirty five pounds of Tobacco
and One hundred and fifty six pounds Two Shillings &
Ten pence halfpenny Current Money as by the Journals
