

The following PRIVATE LAWS were also Enacted this Sessions.

An ACT to Inroll and Record an Indenture between *Matthias Van Bebber* of the one Part, and *Thomas Bordley, Esq;* of the other Part.

An ACT for the Naturalization of *John Hendrickson*, a Native of Rotterdam in Holland, &c.

An ACT to confirm Two Deeds of Sale, the one from *George Oldfield*, and *Petronella*, his Wife; and the other from *Richard Carr*, &c.

An ACT to Record a Deed of Bargain and Sale, made by *Thomas Humphreys, Esq;* and *Mary* his Wife, to *John Gresham, Esq;*

An ACT to cut off an Entail of a Tract of Land, called *Marsh's Seat*, &c.

An ACT to Record and make Valid in Law, a Deed from *John Watmore*, &c.

An ACT to enable the Clerk of *Dorchester County*, to deliver a Deed of Bargain and Sale, from the Heirs of *Henry Bray* to *William Cornwallis*, unto *Richard Bennett, Esq;* &c.

An ACT for cutting off the Entail, and investing an Estate of Inheritance in Fee Simple, of a Tract of Land, called *Exeter*, &c.

ACTS Dissented to, by the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietor.

AN Act for ascertaining the Form of the Oath of Judge or Justice, made in the Year 1728, and printed in the 1st Page of the Book of Laws of that Session.

An Act for Improving the Staple of Tobacco, made the same Year, and printed in Pag. 2, &c. of the said Book.

A Supplementary Act to the Act, Intituled, *An Act for the Establishment of Religious Worship in this Province, according to the Church of England, and for the Maintenance of Ministers*, made in the same Year, and printed in Pag. 9, &c. of the said Book.

An Act concerning the Parishes in *St. Mary's and Charles Counties*, made in the Year 1729, and printed in Pag. 14, &c. of the said Book of Laws.

An Act Reviving and Continuing an Act, Intituled, *An Act to restrain the ill Practices of Attornies, and to prevent their taking Money-Fees*, &c. made in the Year 1725, and Reviv'd by this Act made 1729, and printed in Pag. 283, &c. of the Bound Body of Laws.

ACTS Repeal'd this Session.

PART of an Act against false Packing, false Taring, &c. is Repeal'd by a Clause in the Act for Improving the Staple of Tobacco, printed in Page 11. of this Book.

An Act for the Preservation of the Breed of Wild Deer, made last Session of Assembly; is Repeal'd by an Act made this Session, printed in Pag. 37, 38, of this Book.

All Clauses or Articles in any Act of Assembly heretofore made, relating to the limiting of Attornies Fees, are Repeal'd by a Clause in the Act to ascertain the Fees of Practitioners of the Law, made this Session, and printed in Page 42, of this Book.

Reviv'd this Session.

PART of an Act ascertaining the Gauge and Tare of Tobacco Hogsheads, &c. printed in Page 181, of the Bound Body of Laws, is Reviv'd and Continu'd by an Act made this Session, Intituled, *An Act for Improving the Staple of Tobacco*, &c.
