**B**E it Enacted, by the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary, by and with the Advice and Consent of his Lordship's Governor, and the Upper and Lower Houses of Assembly, and the Authority of the same, That an Act of Assembly of this Province entituled, *An Act for ascertaining the Allowance of Petit-Jurors attending the Provincial Court, to limit Costs with Respect to Witnesses, and for settling their Allowance as to itinerant Charges,* made at a Session of Assembly, begun and held at the City of Annapolis, the Twenty-fourth Day of May, Anno Domini One Thousand Seven Hundred Forty and Nine, be, and is hereby continued, and shall remain and be in full Force, for and during the Term of Three Years, and unto the End of the next Session of Assembly, which shall happen after the Expiration of the said Three Years.

**B**E it Enacted, by the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary, by and with the Advice and Consent of his Lordship's Governor, and the Upper and Lower Houses of Assembly, and the Authority of the same, That an Act of Assembly of this Province entituled, *An Act for the destroying Squirrels and Crows, in the several Counties therein mentioned,* made at a Session of Assembly, begun and held at the City of Annapolis, the Third Day of June, Anno Domini One Thousand Seven Hundred and Fifty Two, be, and is hereby continued, and shall remain and be in full Force, for and during the Term of Three Years, and unto the End of the next Session of Assembly, which shall happen after the Expiration of the said Three Years.
