

Acts of Assembly passed in *March*, 1762.

Justices of the said County, yearly, and every Year, during the Continuance of the said recited Act, towards defraying the Charges of the said County: But in Case there should be a Deficiency therein, and that the Profits of the said Warehouse will not be sufficient to answer the necessary Charges and Disbursements of the same, that then and in such Case the Justices aforesaid shall, at their *November* Court yearly, during the Continuance of the said Act, levy such a Sum of Current Money, by an equal Assessment on the several taxable Inhabitants of the said County, as will make up such Deficiency, together with a Salary of Six Pounds *per Cent*, to the Sheriff for collecting the same.

XI. THIS Act to continue and be in force during the Continuance of the said recited Act.

Continuance.

An Act empowering the Justices of Charles County, to Levy on the Taxable Inhabitants of Port-Tobacco Parish, in the said County, a Quantity of Tobacco for the Uses therein mentioned.

I. **W**HEREAS the Vestry men and sundry other Inhabitants of *Port-Tobacco* Parish, in *Charles* County, have, by their humble Petition to this present General Assembly, set forth, That the Chapel of Ease erected in the said Parish is much too small for the Purpose for which it was intended, and for Enlarging the same, have humbly prayed that a Law may pass, empowering the Justices of *Charles* County aforesaid, to Levy on the Taxable Inhabitants of *Port-Tobacco* Parish aforesaid, the Quantity of Twenty-five Thousand Pounds of Tobacco, together with a Salary to the Sheriff for Collecting the same; which being thought reasonable, it is prayed that it may be Enacted,

Preamble.

II. *AND* be it Enacted, by the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary, by and with the Advice and Consent of his Lordship's Governor, and the Upper and Lower Houses of Assembly, and the Authority of the same, That the Justices of *Charles* County, for the Time being, shall and may, and they are hereby authorized and directed, on the Application of the Vestry and Church-wardens of *Port-Tobacco* Parish, in *Charles* County, or the Majority of them, to assess and levy on the Taxable Inhabitants of the said Parish, the aforesaid Quantity of Twenty-five Thousand Pounds of Tobacco, together with the Sheriff's Salary of Five Pounds *per Centum* for Collection, at Two equal annual Assessments; which said Quantity of Twenty-five Thousand Pounds of Tobacco, shall be collected and levied by the Sheriff of the said County, who is hereby authorized and directed to Collect and Levy the same, in the same Manner as other Parish Assessments are by Law directed to be Levied and Collected; and the said Tobacco, when so collected, shall be paid to the said Vestry and Church-wardens, or the Majority of them, who are hereby authorized and directed to lay out and apply the same in Building and fully Compleating an Addition to the Chapel of Ease aforesaid, in such Manner as to them shall seem most fit and convenient.

25,000 Wt. of Tobacco to be levied in *Port-Tobacco* Parish.

An Act for the speedy and effectual Publication of the Laws of this Province; and for the Encouragement of Jonas Green, of the City of Annapolis, Printer.

I. **B**E it Enacted, by the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary, by and with the Advice and Consent of his Lordship's Governor, and the Upper and Lower Houses of Assembly, and the Authority of the same, That there shall be allowed to *Jonas Green*, of the City of *Annapolis*, Printer, the several and respective Sums of Current Money, in the several Counties within this Province, following, to wit, In *Baltimore* County, Thirty Pounds: *Anne-Arundel* County, Twenty-five Pounds Ten Shillings: *Charles* County, Twenty-three Pounds Ten Shillings: *Prince-George's* County, Twenty-three Pounds: *Frederick* County, Twenty Pounds Ten Shillings: *Queen-Anne's* County, Twenty Pounds Five Shillings: *Saint Mary's* County, Nineteen Pounds Ten Shillings: *Dorchester* County, Eighteen Pounds Ten Shillings: *Kent* County, Eighteen Pounds Five Shillings: *Talbot* County, Seventeen Pounds Fifteen Shillings: *Somerset* County, Seventeen Pounds Ten Shillings: *Worcester* County, Sixteen Pounds Fifteen Shillings: *Cecil* County, Sixteen Pounds Ten Shillings: And *Calvert* County, Eleven Pounds Ten Shillings: Which said respective Sums of Money, the Justices of the several County Courts within this Province, are hereby empowered and required to allow and assess in their respective County Levies annually, during the Continuance of this Act, together with the Sheriff's Salary of Five Pounds *per Cent* for Collecting the same. And the several Sums of Money, so to be allowed and assessed as aforesaid, shall be collected by the Sheriff of each respective County, and yearly paid by them respectively, free from any Abatement or Deduction, to the said *Jonas Green*, or his Order, for Printing, Stitching, Covering with Marble or Blue Paper, Vellum or Parchment, and delivering a Copy of the Public Laws made this present Session of Assembly by the last Day of *July*, in this present Year, and the Votes and Proceedings of the Lower House of Assembly of this present Session by the last Day of *August*, in the Year of our Lord Seventeen Hundred and Sixty-two, and also a Copy of the Laws of any future Session within Three Months, and of the Votes and Proceedings of the
