cels, for the Payment of his or her Levies, Debts, or other Duties; nor to CHAP. prohibit any Person to put or take on board any Sloop, Boat, or other Vesicl, any Hogsheads, Calks or Cases of Tobacco, to be Water-born to any Warehouse or Warehouses appointed by this Act, so as the same be not carried out of the Naval Officer's District wherein the faid Tobacco shall be made; nor to prohibit the Owner of any Tobacco to transport his Crops, or any Part thereof, in Hogsheads, Casks or Cases, from one Place to another, for the better handling and managing thereof; nor any Purchaser of Tobacco from bringing the same by Water to be re-packed, sorted, stemmed, or prized, before the same be carried to the said Warehouses, so as such last-mentioned Tobacco be packed in Hogsheads. Casks or Cases.

VI. And be it surther Enacted, That if the Skipper of any Sloop, Boat, No Tobacco or other Vessel, or other Person or Persons to whom the Care and Manage- to be relanded ment thereof shall be entrusted, shall Land or put on Shore any Hogshead, but at Inspec-Cask or Case of Tobacco, put on board the same to be carried to any public nor to be ta-Warehouse, at any other Place or Places than the Warehouse or Warehouses ken out of by this Act appointed for the Passation and Infraction of Trabassis Cask by any by this Act appointed for the Reception and Inspection of Tobacco, or at skipper, &c. some or one of them, or the Wharfs or other Landing to such Warehouse before inspecor Warehouses belonging; or shall put the same on board any other Vessel, ken out frauor suffer the same to be done, so as the same be not delivered; at some of the dulently after faid public Warehouses, without Fraud or Imbezzlement, or shall open any Inspection. Hogshead, Cask or Case of Tobacco, to as aforeraid water-born and Landed, and take thereout any Tobacco before the same be viewed by some Inspector or Inspectors, according to the Directions of this Act; or, after the same has been viewed, shall fraudulently open any Hogshead, Cask or Case, and take thereout any Tobacco, every such Offence shall be adjudged Felony; and the Offender or Offenders shall suffer by Whipping and Pillorying, and paying Fourfold, as in Case of Felony.

VII. Provided always, That nothing herein before contained shall be Proviso, in construed to prohibit the Landing or putting on Shore, any Hogshead, Case of Disor Case of Tobacco, out of any Sloop, Boat, or other Vessel, so as such Land-tress of Weaing be really and bona fide for the Preservation of the Tobacco laden in such Vessel, and that the same be with all convenient Speed, carried thereafter to the Warchouse or Ship (as the Case shall be) to which it was designed, without Imbezzlement.

VIII. Provided also, That if by any Accident, or Negligence of the Tobacco da-Master or Skipper of any Vessel, any Tobacco which hath been viewed and maged in it's formand that in it's Carriage to the Ship in which it is intended to be carriage to stamped, shall, in it's Carriage to the Ship, in which it is intended to be ex- the ship, may ported, receive so much Damage as the Master of such Ship will not receive be relanded, it on board, every Hogshead, Cask, or Case of Tobacco, so damnified, shall, sepacked. with all convenient Speed, be carried to some Warehouse, appointed by this Act, and there lodged, until the Owner of such Tobacco, or Master of the Vessel in which it was damaged, shall have separated the same, and then the remaining good Tobacco shall be stamped by the Inspector or Inspectors, attending such Warehouse, without Fee or Reward.

IX. Provided always, That every Person appointed, or to be appointed, Inspectors to an Inspector, by Virtue of this Act, shall yearly, before he enters upon the give Bond Execution of the faid Office, enter into Bond, with good Surety, before two with Sureties, Magistrates of the County wherein the Inspecting-House, at which such In- Execution of spector shall serve, is situate, in the Penalty of Forty Eight Thousand Pounds their Office. of Tobacco, payable to the Lord Proprietary, his Heirs, and Successors, with Condition for the true and faithful Performance of his Duty, according to the Directions of this Act, and shall also take the following Oath, or A.firmation if a Quaker, that is to fay;
