

Tobacco, clear of all Deductions, and Sheriff's Salary for Collection; to be levied at Three equal Assessments, in order to build a new Church in the said Parish, which being by this present General Assembly thought reasonable: C H A P. V.

II. Be it Enacted, by the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary, by and with the Advice and Consent of his Lordship's Governor, and the Upper and Lower Houses of Assembly, and the Authority of the same, That it shall and may be lawful, to and for the Justices of St. Mary's County Court, for the Time being, and they are hereby authorized and required, at the laying their County Levy in November Court, Seventeen Hundred and Sixty-six, and so in November Court yearly, until the Year Seventeen Hundred and Sixty-eight inclusive, to assess and levy by Three equal Assessments on the Taxable Inhabitants of St. Andrew's Parish, in the said County, a Quantity of Tobacco, not exceeding Two Hundred Thousand Pounds of Tobacco in the whole Three Assessments, clear of the Sheriff's Salary of Five per Cent for Collecting the same, which said Sum of Two Hundred Thousand Pounds of Tobacco, the said Sheriff is hereby authorized and required to collect and receive accordingly; and when so collected and received, to pay the same to the Order of the Vestry-men and Church-wardens of the said St. Andrew's Parish, for the Time being, to be by them applied to the finishing and completing a Parish Church, for the Use of the said Parishioners, and to no other Use or Purpose whatsoever. 200,000<sup>lb</sup>

III. And whereas the Place where the Church now stands, is inconvenient in its Situation to many of the Parishioners, who are desirous to have the same built as near the Center of the said Parish as can be judged; Be it further Enacted, by the Authority aforesaid, That the Rector, Vestry-men and Church-wardens, or the major Part of them of the said Parish, are hereby authorized and impowered to purchase out of the Tobacco hereby granted, Two Acres of Land, which they shall judge the most convenient Place in the said Parish, for erecting and building the said Church upon, and which Two Acres, when purchased, shall be and remain to and for the Use of the Parish aforesaid, for ever. C H A P. VI.

An ACT to enable the Justices of St. Mary's County Court, to assess and levy on the Taxable Inhabitants of All-Faith's Parish, a Quantity of Tobacco, and for other Purposes therein mentioned.

WHEREAS it is represented to this General Assembly, by a Petition from the Vestry-men and Protestant Inhabitants of the Parish of All-Faith's, in St. Mary's County, that the Church of the said Parish is utterly decayed, and that the Inhabitants of the said Parish are in Want of a new Church, and also a Chapel of Ease, and have by their Petition prayed, that a Quantity of Tobacco, not exceeding One Hundred and Twenty Thousand, may be assessed and levied on the Taxable Inhabitants of the said Parish, at not less than Three equal Assessments and Collections, for the Purpose of building and erecting a new Church, and also a Chapel of Ease for the said Parish. And whereas they have further by their Petition set forth, that there are upwards of Two Hundred Taxables which were extra-parochial before the Death of the Rev<sup>d</sup> Mr. Urquhart, and which by his Death became added and united to All-Faith's Parish, and that the several and respective Sheriffs of St. Mary's County, from the Time the said Taxable Inhabitants became extra-parochial, have collected and received the Thirty per Poll, without accounting to any one for the same, and they have prayed, that the Tobacco so by the Sheriffs collected and received from those Preamble.
