

the Scalps or Heads, were actually killed in the County where produced; any Thing in this Act to the contrary notwithstanding. C H A P. XXXVI.

VI. And whereas it is represented to this present General Assembly, that red Foxes have been found to be very injurious to the Inhabitants of Kent and Queen-Anne's Counties: Be it Enacted, by the Authority aforesaid, That from and after the End of this present Session of Assembly, every Person who shall kill or destroy any red Fox in the aforesaid Counties of Kent and Queen-Anne's, and shall bring the Head of the same, to any Justice of the Peace for the aforesaid Counties, who is hereby required to burn, or otherways destroy the same, and give the Person so bringing such Fox's Head, a Certificate thereof, shall be allowed for every such Head in the County Levy, the Quantity of Twenty Pounds of Tobacco. Allowance of 20 lb Tobacco for red Foxes in Kent and Queen-Anne's.

VII. Provided always, That no Person whatsoever, other than those who shall be Residents in the aforesaid Counties of Kent and Queen-Anne's, shall be entitled to such Reward as is herein before directed, nor any such Residents, until he, she, or they, shall first make Oath before a Justice of the Peace, or Affirmation (if a Quaker) or make appear by the Oath or Affirmation (if a Quaker) of some other credible Person, that such Fox was, to his, her, or their Knowledge, or the Knowledge of such other credible Person, actually killed in the County where the Allowance is prayed. To be paid to Residents only.

VIII. Provided also, That the Sum allowed for every Fox's Head, shall and may be collected, paid, and discharged, by the Inhabitants of the said Counties of Kent and Queen-Anne's, respectively, as other Public and County Levies are collected, paid, and discharged. May be paid as Public Dues.

IX. This Act to continue Three Years, and until the End of the next Session of Assembly, which shall happen after the Expiration of the said Three Years. Duration.

C H A P. XXXVII.

An ACT for the speedy and effectual Publication of the Laws of this Province; and for the Encouragement of Jonas Green, of the City of Annapolis, Printer.

BE it Enacted, by the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary, by and with the Advice and Consent of his Lordship's Governor, and the Upper and Lower Houses of Assembly, and the Authority of the same, That there shall be allowed to Jonas Green, of the City of Annapolis, Printer, the several and respective Sums of Tobacco, in the several Counties within this Province following, to wit, Allowance in Tobacco to J. Green,

- In Baltimore County, Five Thousand One Hundred and Sixty.
- Anne-Arundel County, Four Thousand Three Hundred and Eighty-six.
- Charles County, Four Thousand and Forty-two.
- Prince-George's County, Three Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-six.
- Frederick County, Three Thousand Five Hundred and Twenty-six.
- Queen-Anne's County, Three Thousand Four Hundred and Eighty-three.
- St. Mary's County, Three Thousand Three Hundred and Fifty-four.
- Dorchester County, Three Thousand One Hundred Eighty-two.
- Kent County, Three Thousand One Hundred and Thirty-nine.
- Talbot County, Three Thousand and Fifty-three.
- Somerset County, Three Thousand and Ten.
- Worcester County, Two Thousand Eight Hundred and Eighty-one.
- Cecil County, Two Thousand Eight Hundred Thirty-eight. And
- Calvert County, Nineteen Hundred and Ninety.
