

C H A P. XXII.

An ACT to give *Thomas Harrifon* further Time to effect the Removal of a Nuisance in *Baltimore-Town*, in *Baltimore County*.

Preamble.

WHEREAS *Thomas Harrifon*, by his humble Petition to this General Assembly, has set forth, That in Pursuance of the Act, entitled, *An Act to remove a Nuisance in Baltimore-Town, in Baltimore County, and for other Purposes therein mentioned*, and within the Time prescribed by the said Act, he, the said *Thomas Harrifon*, did elect to remove his Part of the said Nuisance, at his own proper Charge and Expence, and did execute such Bond, in such Penalty, and with such Condition, as by the said Act was directed; but, that the Removal of the said Nuisance, is so difficult a Labour, that he cannot effect the same, within the Time limited by the said Act; and therefore the said *Thomas Harrifon*, by his said Petition, prayed further Time for doing of the same; and, as a further Time appears to this General Assembly to be reasonable and necessary;

Two Years further Time allowed him, than by a former Act.

II. Be it therefore Enacted, by the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary, by and with the Advice and Consent of his Lordship's Governor, and the Upper and Lower Houses of Assembly, and the Authority of the same, That the said *Thomas Harrifon*, for effecting the Removal of his Part of the said Nuisance, have the further Time of Two Years, from the Expiration of the Time limited by the Act aforesaid.

A former Bond given, still to stand as a Security.

III. And be it further Enacted, That the Bond aforesaid, passed and executed as aforesaid, by the said *Thomas Harrifon*, shall have no other Effect, or Operation, than to stand as a Security, for effecting the Removal of his Part of the said Nuisance, within the Time given by this Act.

C H A P. XXIII.

An ACT to empower *Mary Philpot*, Widow and Administratrix of *Brian Philpot*, late of *Baltimore-Town*, in *Baltimore County*, Merchant, deceased, to sell the real Estate of her said Husband, for the Payment of the Debts of the said *Brian Philpot*. [*A Private Act.*]

C H A P. XXIV.

An ACT for the building of a Parish Church, and Chapel of Ease, in *Saint John's Parish*, in *Queen-Anne's County*.

Preamble.

WHEREAS it has been represented to this General Assembly, by sundry the Inhabitants of *St. John's Parish*, in *Queen-Anne's County*, That the Parish Church is greatly impaired, and that there is a Necessity for building in the said Parish, not only a Parish Church, but also a Chapel of Ease, and that there is now in the Hands of the Vestry of the said Parish, about the Sum of Twelve Hundred Pounds Current Money, to be applied for that Purpose: And, whereas there are various Opinions amongst the Parishioners of the said Parish, about the Places whereon it may be proper to place the said Church, and Chapel of Ease, it is therefore thought fit, by this General Assembly, for settling all Differences among the Parishioners aforesaid, to enact;

The Vestrymen empowered to build on 2 Acres of Land, given by *T. Wright*,

II. And be it Enacted, by the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary, by and with the Advice and Consent of his Lordship's Governor, and the Upper and Lower Houses of Assembly, and the Authority of the same, That the Vestrymen of the said Parish, or the major Part of them, shall be, and they are hereby empowered to erect and build, on Two Acres of Land, laid out and given by *Mr. Thomas Wright*, for the Use of the said Parish, at a Place called and known
