to the great Vexation and Prejudice of the Inhabitants of this Province; for further Remedy whereof,

.II. Be it Enacted, by the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary, by and Every Master with the Advice and Consent of his Lordship's Governor, and the Upper and Lower who stall im-Houses of Assembly, and the Authority of the same, That every Master of a port any Fe-Ship, or other Vessel, that shall, after the First Day of October next, import province, any Felon into this Brovince, who hath been, or shall be convicted of any shall bring a Crime, shall bring a full Transcript of the Record of such Conviction, and full Transcript of the Proceedings relating thereto, under the Seal of the Court where such Record of his Conviction is, or shall be had, if there is any Seal of such Court, and if Conviction, there is no such Seal, then under the Hand and Seal of the Clerk, for the Time being, of such Court, and such Transcript shall deliver to the Consignee of such convicted Felon, or such other Person or Persons, as shall have the Sale of such convicted Felon.

III. And be it further Enacted, That any Consignee, or other Person, And the Perhaving the Sale of any convicted Felon, who shall be imported into this the Sale of Province, after the said First Day of October next, shall, within Thirty such Felou; Days after the Sale of any such convicted Felon, or within the same Time the Transafter his Discharge of any convicted Felon, deliver such Transcript, as cript to Naforesaid, to the Clerk of the Court of the County wherein the Purchaser the Clerk of of such convicted Felon shall reside, or in which such convicted Felon shall where the be put on Shore, under the Penalty of Ten Pounds Current Money; and Purchaser the Clerks of the County Courts, respectively, shall, at the Expence of the under Penal-Person delivering such Transcript, as soon as may be, carefully enter the ty, &. Transcript in a Book to be provided and kept for the Purposes, and only the Purposes of this Act, and shall orderly insert the Name of such convicted Felon, and the Page in which his Transcript shall be recorded, in an Alphabet towards the End of such Book, under the Penalty of Five Pounds Current Money for every Omission, and a Copy of the Entry of such Transcript, under the Seal of the Court to which such Book belongs, shall be good Evidence, to prove any Person therein named as such a convicted Felon. Provided and declared nevertheless, That no other Mode of Evidence, which is legal or now used in this Province, shall be hereby, excluded. And whereas, for want of due Care and Attention of Masters, convicted Felons who are imported, and held as Servants in this Province, frequently commit Murders, Robberies, and other Crimes and Offences.

III. Be it therefore Enacted, That every Inhabitant within this Province, Every Inhawho shall purchase any convicted Felon, imported after the said First Day bitant within of October next, shall, within Twenty Days after such Purchase, go before who shall pursome Justice of the Peace of the County where such Purchaser shall reside, chase any Feand shall before such Justice, who it is hereby declared shall take the same, shall enter inenter into Recognizance to the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary, for to Recognithe Time being, in the Sum of Twenty Pounds Current Money, with Con- zance for his dition thereto, that if such convicted Felon, naming him, or her, shall viour, during keep the Peace, and be of good Behaviour towards all his Majesty's Subjects, the Time for during the Time for which such convicted Felon was transported, or during Felon was the Time he or her shall continue in this Province, then such Recognizance transported, shall be void: Which Recognizance, immediately after the Caption thereof, &c. shall be delivered to the Person entering into the same, who shall, within Ten Days thereafter, deliver the same to the Clerk of the Court, of the County in which such Purchaser shall reside, under the Penalty of Twenty Pounds Current Money, for every Neglect to enter into such Recognizance, or deliver the same to the Clerk as aforesaid: And such County Clerk to whom such Recognizance shall be delivered as aforesaid, shall, as soon thereafter as may be, at the Charge of the Recognizor, enter the faid Recogni-
