

II. Be it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the treasurer of the western shore shall, and is hereby authorised and required, to deliver out of the bills of credit which now are or shall be in his hands, for the use of this state, to the several persons, their ex-ecutors, administrators, assigns, or orders, who are allowed on the said journal, or to such of them as shall offer to receive the same, the several sums of money allowed to them respectively, as they appear to be al-lowed, stated, and ascertained, by the journal of accounts and list of debts aforesaid.
