

C H A P. IV.

Passed April 6.

An ACT to revive and aid the proceedings of Worcester county court.

Preamble.

WHEREAS the justices of Worcester county court did not meet pursuant to their adjournment of November term, seventeen hundred and ninety, and divers actions, suits and proceedings, civil and criminal, were discontinued; for aiding, therefore, the said actions, suits and proceedings, and for saving, as far as may be, parties interested from the damage that might otherwise be occasioned by such discontinuance,

Actions, &c. to be valid.

II. Be it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That all actions, suits and proceedings, depending in the said court, shall be and are hereby as good and valid as if the same had been continued by the order or judgment of the said court, any thing to the contrary notwithstanding.

Judgments confirmed.

III. And be it enacted, That all judgments rendered at or since said November term, seventeen hundred and ninety, shall be and are hereby confirmed in as full force and power as if the same suits had been regularly continued.

C H A P. V.

Passed April 6.

An additional supplement to the act, entitled, An act directing the time, places and manner, of holding elections for representatives of this state in the congress of the United States, and for appointing electors on the part of this state for choosing a president and vice-president of the United States, and for the regulation of the said elections, and also to repeal the act of assembly therein mentioned.

Elections to be made in November, &c.

Be it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the election of electors for the purpose of choosing a president and vice-president of the United States, shall be made by the citizens of this state, qualified to vote for members of the house of delegates, on the second Wednesday in November next, and on the second Wednesday in November in every fourth year for ever thereafter.

Parts of an act repealed, &c.

II. And be it enacted, That all that part of the act to which this is an additional supplement, which directs the holding the aforesaid election at a different time from that herein before appointed, and all parts of the same which are inconsistent with the act of congress passed at a session, begun and held at the city of Philadelphia on Monday the twenty-fourth day of October, one thousand seven hundred and ninety-one, entitled, An act relative to the election of a president and vice-president of the United States, and declaring the officer who shall act as president in case of vacancies in the offices both of president and vice-president, shall be and the same are hereby repealed, and that, in all other respects, the election of the said electors shall be made agreeably to the provisions of the several acts of assembly now in force for the regulation of the same.

C H A P. VI.

Passed April 5.

A Supplement to an act, entitled, An act supplementary to an act, entitled, An act for the more effectual paving the streets of Baltimore-town, in Baltimore county, and for other purposes.

Assessors to be allowed a salary, &c.

Be it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the street commissioners, or a major part of them, be authorized and empowered to allow to the assessors by them appointed respectively under an act, entitled, An act to regulate the affize of bread, a salary not exceeding the sum of thirty-five pounds per annum for their services, and that the said street commissioners, or a majority of them, be authorized to apply for that purpose so much as may be necessary of any of the funds, which, by the present laws of this state, have or may come to their hands.
