Whereas that perfidious & perjured Fellow Servant whom we lately Intrusted to be our Lieutenant of Maryland to cloake his treacherous & ambitious designs & contrary to his Oath & Trust to incite the people there to join with him in raising a Sedition & Faction against our Jurisdiction & Right of Government there made a sinister Use as we are credibly informed of a passage of our Letter to him of the seventeenth of Nov.
