Be it Enacted by the Lord Proprietary with the Consent of this
present General Assembly that each respective County shall this next En-
suing Crop satisfy their respective Burgeses Charges Attendance for
this Assembly, & that Mr. Hannah Lee be paid out of the publick Levy
one thousand pounds of Tob.^o and John Shanks be paid likewise
out of the publick Levy 300 pounds of Tobacco & also to proceed
immediately to conclude the Sessions

An Act for the Burgeses Expences

Be it Enacted by the Lord Proprietary by and with the Consent
of this present General Assembly that every County shall satisfy
unto their respective Burgeses all their necessary Expence this Assem-
bly for meat Drink & Lodging for themselves & all Charges of Boat
& Hands at this next ensuing Crop as also one thousand pounds of
Tobacco to Hannah Lee Widow for House Broom & that Jn^s. Shanks
be paid three hundred pounds of Tob.^o & that Mr Will^m. Bretton be
paid two thousand pounds of Tob.^o & Mr John Gittings one thou-
sand pounds of Tobacco & five hundred pounds of Tob.^o to Jn^s. Metcalf
Door-keeper.

Ordered that this Paper be sent to the Lower House for
their Concurrence in it & that Mr Lloyd who carries it desire them
to confer it with their own Paper & see whither their Request be not
answered in Serminis & that they signify their Assent or Dissent
with Speed that the Sun may not set before we conclude the Sessions

Then came the Speaker & members of the Lower House to give
their Assent to the said Act & to conclude the Sessions

The two Houses after the reading of the Laws joined in this Declaration
that all publick money by these Acts to be levied shall be assessed by
the Governour & Council as also the publick Charge of three thousand
pounds of Tob.^o brought into the Lower House this day for publick Ex-
pences. Which being Ended the Chancellour by order from the S^t. Gener.
