Ordered that an Act be prepared for the Plaintiff to file his Bill or Declaration against the Defend: three days before the Court begins & regulating the proceedings at Law

The Upper House was adjourned till to Morrow Morning at Nine of the Clock

Came a message from the Lower House to desire to know whether the Book of Laws Entituled a Copy of all the Laws now in force within the Province of Maryland were the Bodys of all the Laws in force or not

Ordered that the Book of Laws now Examined by the Upper House be subscribed by the Clerk of this House as all the Laws now in force within this Province

Ordered that a member of this House be sent to the Lower House with a memoriall viz. to provide a Law against Exportation of Sleydes & Wool, To provide a Law to punish Contempts in Court or out of Court by not standing bareheaded &c. before Courts or Magistrates, To provide a Law to punish such as shall take away or otherwise dispose of Tobaccos after they are seized or by the Sheriff for fines Levys or Rents, or for the Speaker To provide a Law to give Smiths Execution for their accounts under hand Writing or Bills given for Smiths Work done as the ordinary Keeper hath

Ordered that a Copy of all the heads of the Laws ordered to be taken into Consideration by this House be sent to the Lower House & that they be desired to let this House know which of them they have already taken into Consideration & that they will send to the Upper House all the Bills that they have ready that we may take them into Consideration

The House Adjourned for an hour.
