

The Upper House upon a review of the Act for killing wild Cattle think it fitter to repeale the whole Act than to let it pass without the Words viz with Licence from the Lieutenant General & that they be desired to draw up an Act for the repeale of it.

Upon the List called the Titles of certain Acts to be drawn up by the Upper House was Endorsed viz.

Mr. Henry Sewall was sent to the Lower House with all the Acts assented unto by this House & the other papers.

Upon reading the Act Entituled an Act that shall pass Current under the value of 300 Tobacco.

Ordered that the Lower House be desired that instead of these Words in the Act / or the value thereof in Tobo. these words be inserted, or 3<sup>rd</sup> of Tobo.

Then came Mr. John Bateman / There came a message from the Lower House and desired that since the Act Entituled an Act for Addition to and Amendment of the Secretarys Fees was rejected by the major Vote of this House they desired that the Act made last Assembly Entituled an Act concerning the Secretary & addition to his Fees might stand and be in force as it is.

Resolved that It be put to the Vote whether the Act made the last Assembly Entituled an Act concerning the Secretarys addition to his Fees shall stand and be in force as it is or not?

Then was read an Act for Seating all Lands in Baltimore County & assented unto
