the moiety of any the Lands Tenements or Hereditaments of the said Gerard within St Marys County until the said Sum of 1000 Sterling due to the said Snowe as afd. be satisfied which said Writt being returned by our said Sheritt executed upon the moiety of the Manour of St Clements in the said County of St Marys, The said Tho: Gerard brought our writt of Error in radicione Execution in Upper House of Assembly held at St Marys the 10<sup>th</sup> day of April 1666 assigned for Error amongst other Things that the Order of our Provincial Court granted ex post facto for an Extent against the Lands of the said Gerard after Snowe had thereon a lura facias was Error And our said Upper House of Assembly reading the Records Proceedings of our said Provincial Court therein viewing & considering of the same did find the said Order & Extent thereupon grounded to be erroneous whereupon our sd. Upper House of Assembly ordered that the said Order & Extent should be reversed & that the hands of the said Snowe should be removed from the possession of the Lands of the said Gerard by virtue thereof so extended, & the said Gerard to be put in full & quiet possession & seisure of the same.

These are therefore to will & require you that you do forthwith remove the said Snowe or any other persons whatsoever claiming by pretence of the said Extent from the possession of the moiety of the Manour of St Clements in our County of St Marys so extended as afd. And to deliver seisure & possession thereof to the sd. Thomas Gerard quietly & peaceably to Enjoin the same as in his former Right, and this shall be your warrant for so doing and that you make return of the Execution of this Precept Witness our Dear brother Philip Calvert Esq<sup>r</sup> our Chancellor of our Province of Maryland this 29<sup>th</sup> April 1666
