Cacilius Sr. To our dear Son Charles Calvert Esq^r Lieuten^t General & chief Governour of our said Province of Maryland & of the Dominions thereunto belonging Greeting We do hereby will & require you that at the next General Assembly of the Deputys & Delegates of the Freemen..... of our said Province to be assembled you do declare & publish our Disassent & disaprobaton of & unto the severall Acts of Assembly made at & by a General Assembly of the said Freemen of our said Province or of their Delegates & Deputys begun the 15th September which was in the year of our Lord God 1663 & continued by adjournment until the 6th September which was in the year of our Lord God 1664 hereafter mentioned that is to say of & unto one certain Act Entituled an Act for the quietting & possession of Lands & Establishing the manner of Conveyances of Land for the future, one other Act Entituled an Act for appointing a publick Notary one other Act Entituled an Act for the preservation of Orphan's Estates, one other Act Entituled an Act for the Rule of Arrests & Summons for the witnesses by all Sheriffs & a Rule for entering Actions..... & filing Actions & Petitions, one other Act Entituled an Act for proceeding at Law, one other Act Entituled an Act for seating of Lands in Baltimore County, one other Act Entituled an Act providing what shall be good Evidence upon Bonds & Specialties coming out of England & other parts, & one other Act Entituled an Act concerning payment of debts due by will singular which said severall & respective Acts we do now approve disassent unto, and we do by this our Commission require you to publish & declare our disassent unto the said severall & respective Acts in them every or any of them mentioned above in our hand & seal at 16th day of 1664 year of our Lord God 1664 our said Province & in the presence of your account now in England we
