The House met Present as yesterday in the
Afternoon except The Chancellour

The Lower House by several of their Members acquainted the
Governour & this House that they had dispatched what Busi-
ness was before them & desired his Honour that they might
be dismissed.

Whereupon his Honour told them that he stayd here for
that purpose.

The Lower House sent up an Act for payment of publick
Debts which being read & the Question put

Resolved that the same do pass.

This House desired J^r. W^m. Talbot to acquaint the Lower House
that the Governour was ready to prorogue this Assembly & to
desire them to bring up the Laws enacted by this Assembly

Then the Lower House with their Speaker came into this house
with all the Laws made this Assembly.
