Exploit Lloyd did to Inform this House that the Lower house have agreed with Captain Dingley for three hundred thousand pounds of Tobacco to build the State house according to the Dimensions drawn up in the Act for the same to be paid half when half done and the rest when quite finished also the said Dingley in the said time and for the same Consideration is to build a Brick or Stone Prison of twenty four feet long and twelve wide & a Parlatore on it and left and to finish all by the last of October here two years or else to perfect his Work and pay the said thousand pounds of Tobacco for which he is to give Security & accordingly also this House took request of the said Dingley may have the Benefit of keeping the Prison for seven years -

Read in this house a Petition presented by Captain Hugh Brock humbly praying a License for Importation of Horses from New York into this Province and upon the said Petition an Ordinance from the Lower House as follows vizt That this house Petition his Excellency to grant the Petitioner Hugh Brock a License to Import thirty eight Horses between this and the last of August into this Province to be brought in at one time in one Gang Provided that when as he arrives in this Province he shall go to two of the Commissioners of Baltimore County and acquaint them with the number of Horses he hath brought with him that they may certify the time of his arrival and the number of Horses Horses or Cattle and of the said Brock that he and the number or not bring them altogether or not Province such Certificate from two Justices of the Peace within three Months to be perfected notwithstanding the said Ordinance and this house doth Petition his Excellency accordingly -
