Lower house 13th May 1682

This house have read a certificate from the Commissioners of St. Maries County ^{concerning} Wadden Hanse the Daughter of one Hanse a Sweed who was killed at the Susquehanna fort, and thereupon Voted that four thousand Pounes be raised this year out of the Publick and ordered to be paid in St. Maries County, that one thousand pounes thereof be paid to William Wherritt for his keeping the Child hitherto, that the other three thousand be paid to the Commissioners of St. Maries County to be by them paid to such person as shall take the Child as an Appren-tice or Orphan Child, till she shall come to Eighteen years of Age, the Person that takes her to Oblige to teach the Girl to read and Some, also Voted that the Girl be further considered when she comes to Marry or at the Expiration of her time
