We have no Business left before this House and humbly pray your Majesty that a Conclusion be put to this Session

Whereupon the honorable Col^l John Addison and James Fabyan Esq^s were to command. W^{ch} Speaker and the House immediately to attend the Council in Council. Came W^{ch} Speaker and the House of Deputies and presented the following Bills viz

- 1 A Bill concerning the Rights of a certain Tract of Land to the Nanticoke Indians so long as they shall occupy and be in possession
- 2 A Bill empowering Trustees to purchase Lands belonging to the Prisoners of Healing Water called the Cool Spring
- 3 A Bill for the more Speedy Conveying of the publick Taxes and Rates of the Province and setting a Revenue upon the Sheriff for defraying the Charge thereof
- 4 A Bill to Enable William Courney and Elizabeth his Wife to sell and Acknowledge such Lands as were left by Col^l Vincent Courney sold for the Payment of his just debts
- 5 A Bill for the more Effectual Suppressing of profane Swearing
- 6 A Bill for empowering Vestry men to Appt their Parish for building or repairing Churches

- 7 A Bill Appointing how Publick Offices shall be filled
- 8 A Bill for the Punishment of Pirates and Rogues
- 9 A Bill for vesting two Tracts of Land in John ...
- 10 A Bill for preventing Sheriff from Summoning Deputies and Justices of the Peace to serve as Jurors in the Province
- 11 A Bill for Defraying the publick Levy of this Province
