

No. 102. A Supplement to the act, entitled, An act for the relief of sundry insolvent debtors, passed at the present session of assembly.

No. 103. A Further additional supplementary act to the act, entitled, An act for quieting possessions, enrolling conveyances, and securing the estates of purchasers.

No. 104. An act to authorize the justices of the levy court of Prince-George's county to levy a sum of money on the assessable property of said county for the purposes therein mentioned.

No. 105. An act to establish and incorporate a medical and chirurgical faculty or society in the state of Maryland.

No. 106. An act respecting writs of *habeas corpus*.

No. 107. An act for the promotion of literature in this state.

No. 108. An act declaring what shall be evidence in certain cases therein mentioned.

No. 109. An act for the relief of Peter Redhead, of Talbot county, an insolvent debtor.

No. 110. A Further supplement to the act, entitled, An act for building a new gaol in Baltimore county.

No. 111. A Further supplement to the act, entitled, An act directing the time, places and manner, of holding elections for representatives of this state in the congress of the United States, and for appointing electors on the part of this state for choosing a president and vice-president of the United States, and for the regulation of the said elections, and also to repeal the acts of assembly therein mentioned.

No. 112. An act to authorize Jane Green, administratrix of Valentine Green, to dispose of part of the real estate of said Green, and for other purposes therein mentioned.

No. 113. An act to lay a tax on billiard tables.

No. 114. An act to increase the fees of the examiner-general of the western shore and the examiner of the eastern shore.

No. 115. An act to alter, abolish and repeal, certain parts of the constitution and form of government of this state as are therein mentioned.

No. 116. An act to alter, abolish and repeal, such parts of the constitution and form of government of this state as are therein mentioned.

No. 117. An act for the payment of the journal of accounts.

The senate adjourns until the first Monday in November next.
