

- No. 102. An *ACT* to empower the clerk of Calvert county to remove certain records from the seat of justice.
- No. 103. An *ACT* to extend the powers of the levy court of Harford county in the case therein mentioned.
- No. 104. An *ACT* to authorise the vestry of Saint-Paul's parish, in Baltimore county, to draw a lottery within the city of Baltimore.
- No. 105. An *ACT* to authorise the sale of certain lots of land lying westward of Fort Cumberland.
- No. 106. An *ACT* to continue an act, entitled, An act to incorporate the Maryland Insurance company, passed at November session, seventeen hundred and ninety-five.
- No. 107. A Further supplement to the act, entitled, An act to enlarge the powers of the high court of chancery.
- No. 108. An *ACT* to make permanent, and to continue, the acts of assembly therein mentioned.
- No. 109. An *ACT* to extend the powers of the trustees of the poor of Montgomery county.
- No. 110. An *ACT* for the relief of sundry insolvent debtors.
- No. 111. An *ACT* for the payment of the journal of accounts.
