THE Committee to whom was referred the petition of Edward Tillard of Montgomery county, report, That they have taken the same into consideration, and believe the facts stated therein to be true ; they therefore submit the following resolution :

Resolved, That the treasurer of the Western Shore be, and he is hereby directed to pay unto Edward Tillard, of Montgomery county, or to his order annually, in quarterly payments during life, a sum of money equal to the half pay of a lieutenant colonel, as a provision to him in his indigent situation, and as a further remuneration to him for those services rendered his country during our revolutionary war.
