An act to prevent geese and swine from going at large in the town of Upper Marlborough, in Prince George's county. 216. An act to avoid suits at law. 217. A further additional supplement to the act, entitled, An act for amending and reducing into system the laws and regulations concerning last wills and testaments, the duties of executors, and administrators, and the rights of orphans, and other representatives of deceased persons.

The senate adjourns until the first Monday in December next.
