And then on motion, from respect to the memory of Thomas P. Bennett, Esquire, late a member of the house of delegates, of whose death the senate this morning received the melancholy intelligence,

Saturday February 24th, 1827.

The senate met. Present the same members as on yesterday. The proceedings of yesterday were read.

On motion, the resolution in favour of John S. Maffitt, of Cecil county, was referred to Messrs. Dennis, Whiteley and Nelson.

The bill to change the names, of the bank of Westminster and office of pay and receipt to the Farmers and Mechanics Bank of Frederick county, and to locate said bank at Frederick city, with a branch at Westminster, was read the first, and by special order a second and third time and passed.

Mr. Marriott from the committee, reported a bill entitled, an act relating to division fences, between different proprietors in Anne Arundel county, which was read the first and by special order a second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading, the same having been engrossed, was read a third time, by special order and passed.

The bill relating to bail in civil actions, was read a third time and passed.
