

The bill to provide for the payment of Jurors in Dorchester County, was read a second time.

The Senate proceeded to the consideration of the bill, entitled, a supplement to an act, entitled, an act against Excessive Usury, the same being the order of the day, when on motion of Mr. Spence, it was postponed until Tuesday next, the 15th instant.

On motion of Mr. Forrest, the bill, entitled, a further additional supplement to the act, entitled, an act for the relief of sundry Insolvent Debtors, was made the order of the day for Wednesday, the 23d instant.

The Senate proceeded to the consideration of the bill to confirm the name of Lufkin Tall Traverse, alias Lufkin Tall. The said bill was then read a third time, passed, and returned to the house of delegates.

The resolution proposing the appointment of a joint committee of both houses to wait on the Executive, and request a report of the progress made by the gentlemen appointed to revise, digest and collate the public acts of Assembly of this State, &c. was read the second and by special order a third time, and dissented from.

Gentlemen of the House of Delegates,

The Senate received your message proposing the appointment of a joint committee of the two houses, whose duty it should be to transmit the accompanying resolution to the Executive. The Senate cannot concur in the proposition, inasmuch as the passage of a joint resolution and the appointment of a joint committee, do not appear necessary to the attainment of the object in view. The information sought for can be more readily obtained by an order of either house requesting information of the Executive. This it is believed is the more usual and convenient method.
