

The additional supplement to the act concerning crimes and punishments, passed at November session, one thousand eight hundred and nine, was read a third time by special order and passed.

The senate adjourned until to-morrow morning 10 o'clock.

Tuesday, January 22, 1828.

The Senate met. Present the same members as on yesterday.

The proceedings of yesterday were read.

The additional supplement to the act entitled, an act concerning crimes and punishments, passed at November session, one thousand eight hundred and nine, was sent to the house of delegates.

Mr. Heath from the committee, reported a bill entitled, an act to incorporate the Neptune Insurance Company, which was read the first time.

The president laid before the senate a letter from Arnold E. Jones, Esq. accepting his appointment as a member of the Executive Council, which was read and referred to the house of delegates.

The supplement to the act, for the benefit of the infant children of Benjamin B. Wroth, late of Kent county, deceased, passed December session, 1825, chapter 217; was read a second time.

The bill directing the manner in which the Free School fund in Anne-Arundel county shall be applied, was read a second time.

The supplement to the act entitled, an act relative to justices of the peace, and for other purposes, passed at December session, 1815, chapter 82, was read a third time, passed and returned to the house of delegates.

The bill to abolish all such parts of the Constitution and form of Government as relate to the time and manner of electing the senate, and the mode of filling up vacancies in that body, so that each county and the city of Baltimore may have a senator to be elected immediately by the people; this day entitled to a third reading, was postponed and made the order of the day for Thursday next the 24th inst.

The resolution respecting the claims of the surviving officers and soldiers of the revolution, was read.
