

The clerk of the house of delegates delivered a resolution providing for the re-payment of certain monies paid into the Treasury, under the act of December session, 1821, chapter 246, upon certain conditions, which was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Ways and Means.

Also, a resolution in favor of the States' Agent for the Western Shore, which was read the first time and referred to the Committee of Ways and Means.

Also, a bill entitled, an act relating to the county tax in the city of Baltimore, which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Heath, Lloyd and Kennedy.

Also, a bill entitled, an act to ascertain and settle the salaries of the members of the Council for the present year, which was read the first time.

Also, a bill entitled, an act relating to the swearing of petit jurors, which was read the first time.

Also, a bill entitled, an act to authorise Amos Ewing, to convey a piece of land therein mentioned, to Henry B. Broughton, which was read the first time.

Also, a bill entitled, an additional supplement to an act, for the establishment and support of Public Free Schools in the first election district of Baltimore County, which was read the first time.

Also, a bill entitled, an act to repeal a supplement, passed at December session, 1824, and a supplement, passed at December session, 1825, to an act passed at May session, 1803, entitled, an act to incorporate the Trustees of the Westminster General Meeting House in Frederick county, which was read the first time.

And returned the bill further to amend the act incorporating the Chesapeake and Ohio Canal Company endorsed "will pass."

And delivered a bill entitled, an act for the division of Queen Anns County, into election districts which was read the first time.

Also, a bill entitled, an act for the relief of Baily S. Clark of Prince Georges County, which was read the first time.

And returned the bill heretofore rejected by the Senate, entitled, an act to fix and regulate the time of opening the Orphans Court of Dorchester County on the respective days of meeting of that court, and for other purpose with the following message, which was read.
