

of every part thereof, which by this act, they are authorised to locate and construct, that by the act entitled, an act, to incorporate the Baltimore and the Ohio rail road company, are given, permitted and secured to the said rail road company, and to the president and directors thereof.

After some discussion the bill and amendment, on motion of Mr. Heath, were ordered to lie on the table.

The clerk of the house of delegates delivered a bill to incorporate the Westminster savings institution, which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Kennedy Sewell and Heath.

Also, a bill to authorise the Levy court of Caroline county to make sale of part of the public lands in the village of Denton, in Caroline county, which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Whiteley, Lloyd and Dennis.

Also, a supplement to the act for draining the right prong of a branch in Queen Ann's county, known by the name of the Anderer branch, which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Whiteley, Harrison and Dennis.

Also, a bill entitled an act, for the relief of Thomas Singleton which was read the first time and referred to the committee on insolvencies.

And returned the bill entitled, a further additional supplement to the act entitled, an act for the relief of sundry insolvent debtors, endorsed, 'will pass.'

Mr. Thomas from the committee on ways and means, made an unfavorable report upon the bill to regulate the issuing of licenses to traders, keepers of ordinaries and others, and affixed the following message, which was read.

By the Senate, February 16th, 1828.

Gentlemen of the House of Delegates,

The senate not having the constitutional power to amend the bill entitled, an act to regulate the issuing of licenses to traders, keepers of ordinaries and others, have been constrained to reject it:
