

Mr. Kennedy made a favorable report upon the resolution in favor of Aaron Crawford of Washington county. The resolution was then read a second and by special order a third time, assented to, and returned to the house of delegates.

The senate took up for consideration the order of the day, being the supplement to the act to incorporate a company to make a Turnpike Road, to lead from the Cross Roads near Richard Caton's Lime Kila, in Baltimore county, nearly in the direction of Jones Falls to the city of Baltimore.

On motion of Mr. Johnson, said bill was recommitted.

Mr. Heath from the committee made a favorable report upon the bill to establish the width of Orleans street, in the city of Baltimore. The said bill was then read a second and by special order the third time passed and returned to the house of delegates.

Mr. Rees from the committee made a favorable report upon the bill to incorporate the Trustees of the Millington Academy in Kent County. Said bill was then read a second and by special order a third time, passed, and returned to the house of delegates.

The bill to incorporate a company for erecting a bridge over the Bohemia river at the place where the public ferry is now kept, was read the third time, passed and returned to the house of delegates.

The bill to incorporate the Port Deposit and Columbia turnpike road company, was read a third time; Mr. Heath moved to amend the bill by striking out "twenty acres," in the 16th line of the 4th section and inserting "five acres" which amendment was assented to.

Mr. Heath then moved to amend the bill by adding at the end of the 7th section the words "or of the United States," which amendment was read and assented to.

Mr. Sewell then moved to amend the bill by striking out the words "or any other hard substance," in the 13th line of the said section, which amendment was read and assented to.

The bill thus amended was passed and returned to the house of delegates.
