

Mr. Heath from the committee made a favorable report upon the bill to enable Charles Carroll of Carrollton to receive patents for two warrants of resurvey on certain lands heretofore conveyed in trust by him; the said bill was then read a second, and by special order a third time, passed and returned to the house of delegates.

Mr. Dennis asked and obtained leave to bring in a bill to be entitled, an act for the benefit of Sally Elzey and Wm. Long of Somerset county.—Ordered that Messrs. Dennis, Forrest and Rees be a committee to prepare and report the same. .

The clerk of the house of delegates delivered a resolution requiring the Armourer at Annapolis to deliver to Capt. Thomas Hope of Harford county, certain arms and accoutrements, which was read the first, and by special order a second and thrd time, passed and returned to the house of delegates.

Also, a bill to appoint a state wharfinger in the city of Baltimore, and to authorise the collection of wharfage in certain cases in the said city, which was read the first time.

Also, a bill for the relief of Fitz King, an imprisoned debtor, in the jail of Baltimore county, which was read the first time and referred to the committee on insolvencies.

Also, a bill to regulate the guaging of casks, and the inspection of domestic distilled liquors in this state, which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Kennedy, Heath and Sewell.

Also, a bill to incorporate the Maryland Company for insurance on lives, granting annuities and other purposes, which was read the first time

And returned the bill to incorporate the stockholders of the Hal-co-tal Mining Company of Baltimore, endorsed, 'will pass.'

Also, the supplement to the act to provide for the repair of the public roads in Montgomery county, endorsed will pass with the proposed amendments. Amendments proposed. Strike out the words "any one of the judges thereof shall have power to fill the same," from the end of the bill and insert. "then the levy court of said county shall fill such vacancy, until the next meeting of the county court, and if the levy court should not then be in session, or to meet by appointment in time to prevent inconvenience or injury to the public on account of such vacancy, the clerk of the county court shall appoint a day for the meeting of
