

Rail Road Company; and the said directors of the company, herein before incorporated, or a majority of them, shall have the same right and powers to construct the rail road hereby authorised, to place and use carriages thereon, and to charge for tolls and transportation of persons, produce, or other property, in proportion to the length of such road, as the Baltimore and Ohio Rail Road Company have by their charter to construct, use and charge, in respect to the rail roads mentioned and authorised in the said charter."

Which amendment was read and assented to.

On the further reading of the bill, Mr. Heath moved to amend the same by inserting after the word "Company," in the 10th line of the 9th section the following words "without the limits of the City of Baltimore," which amendment was read and assented to.

On motion of Mr. Herbert, the further consideration of said bill was then postponed until to-morrow.

Mr. Herbert, from the committee, made a favorable report upon the bill entitled, an act to alter and amend the constitution and form of government of this state, so far as it relates to the filling of vacancies in the Council.

The said bill was then read a second time.

Mr. Herbert, from the committee, on internal improvement, made a favorable report upon the bill entitled, an act to repeal an act entitled, an act to create a board of public works, passed at December session 1825, chapter 166.

The said bill was then read a second time.

Mr. Harrison, from the committee to whom was recommit- ted the bill entitled, an act to authorise the Judges of Queen Ann's county Court to issue a commission to divide the estate of the late James Davidson, made a favorable report thereon.

The said bill was then read, and on motion of Mr. Harrison, was ordered to lie on the table.

On motion of Mr. Smith, the amendment proposed by the House of Delegates to the bill entitled, an additional supplement to the act entitled, an act to incorporate a company to make a Turnpike Road from the city of Baltimore to Havre-de-Grace, which amendment is as follows: Strike out the word "ten" in the last line of the bill, and in its place insert the word "five," which was read and assented to.

The said bill was then ordered to be engrossed.

The Senate adjourned until to-morrow morning 10 o'clock.
