

The bill, entitled an act to authorise the transcribing of certain dockets and record books of *Harford* county court; and the bill, entitled a further supplement to the act, entitled an act relating to the city of Baltimore, severally passed by the Senate this morning, were returned to the *House of Delegates*.

The engrossed bills from number 31 to number 41, inclusive, were severally read, assented to, and sent to the *House of Delegates*.

The clerk of the *House of Delegates* returned the said bills, endorsed 'read and assented to.'

And also delivered the engrossed bills from No. 1, to No. 30, inclusive, and from No. 42, to No. 60, inclusive; which were read, assented to, and returned to the *House of Delegates*.

His excellency the Governor having appeared in the Senate chamber,

On motion of Mr. *Heath*, it was

Ordered, That Messrs. *Heath* and *Kennedy* wait on the the Speaker and members of the *House of Delegates*, and inform them that his excellency the Governor is attending in the Senate chamber, ready to sign and seal the engrossed bills, and invite their attendance for the purpose of witnessing the same.

Whereupon the Speaker, attended by the members of the *House of Delegates*, appeared in the Senate chamber, when the engrossed bills from No. 1 to No. 60, inclusive, were presented by the Speaker of the *House of Delegates* to his excellency the Governor, who signed and sealed the same, in the presence of both houses, in accordance with the provisions of the constitution and form of government.

The Speaker and members of the *House of Delegates*, having retired,

The Senate adjourned until to morrow morning ten o'clock.
