A bill entitled, an act to provide for the erection of a bridge over Antietam creek on the road leading from Williams Port to Boonsborough in Washington county; which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Pigman, Sappington and Claude.

A bill entitled, an act for the benefit of the sheriff of Washington county; which was read the first time and referred to the committee on judicial proceedings.

A bill entitled, an act supplementary to the act entitled, an act to lay out and open a road from Harne's old field in Baltimore county, to Lisbon in Anne Arundel county, passed at December session, 1829; which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Montgomery, Osborn and Pigman.

A bill entitled, an act to incorporate the Frederick and Woodsborough turnpike road company; which was read the first time, and referred to the committee on internal improvement.

And returned the preamble and resolutions relative to re-chartering the United States bank; which originated in the senate, endorsed "assented to with the proposed amendment." The proposed amendment which was as follows, was read and assented to: Strike out the word "present," in the 5th line of the 2nd resolution.

On motion of Mr. Hughlett, leave of absence was granted to Mr. Reid.

On motion of Mr. Dennis, the resolutions requesting the senators and representatives of this state in the congress of the United States, to use their exertions to procure appropriations for the establishment and support of proper Buoys at the entrances of the rivers Nanticoke, Manokin, Annamessix, Pocomoke and Wicomico, in the collection districts of Snow Hill and Vienna; was read the third time by special order and assented to.

On motion of Mr. Wootton, the following order was read and adopted:

Ordered, That one hundred copies of the preamble and resolutions on the subject of the renewal of the Charter of the United States Bank be printed for the use of the Senate.
