

2 In the 6th line strike out the words "excepting twelve," and insert the words "reserving twenty five," and in the 7th line strike out the word "reports."

On motion of Mr. Pigman, the resolution with the amendments were ordered to lie on the table.

Mr Emory from the committee to which was referred the bill, entitled, an additional supplement to an act to amend the lottery system, reported favourably thereon.

It was then read the second time.

Mr Mayer from the committee to which was referred the resolution in favour of John Evans reported that the committee had had said resolution under consideration and were of opinion it ought to be assented to with the following amendments, which were read and assented to; to wit:

At the end of the resolution add the following proviso:

"And provided, that nothing herein contained shall prevent the arrest and imprisonment at any time or times hereafter of said Evans under the special order. and at the discretion of Baltimore county court in such behalf, to enforce from him recognizance with moiety for support of the said illegitimate child according to the acts of assembly in such cases of illegitimate children made and provided."

In the last line after the word "nor" insert the word "under."

The resolution was then read the second, and by special order the third time and assented to.
