

WEDNESDAY, February 1, 1832.

The Senate met. Present the same members as on yesterday. The proceedings of yesterday were read.

The message adopted by the Senate on yesterday, proposing a joint committee on the subject of the memorial of the Bank of Baltimore, and several other Banks in the city of Baltimore; And

The memorial of James D. Woodside, were sent; And

The bill, entitled, an act to authorise the granting Writs of Replevin by Justices of the Peace, and for other purposes therein mentioned, rejected by the Senate on yesterday.

The bill, entitled, an act for the benefit of James Hendrixson, Senior, of Allegany county; And

The bill, entitled, an act for the relief of David Bostetter of Washington county, severally passed by the Senate on yesterday, were returned to the house of delegates.

The message delivered by the clerk of the house of delegates on yesterday, was taken up for consideration, and was as follows :

A petition from sundry inhabitants of this state, praying the repeal of an act, entitled, an act to abolish imprisonment for debt on certain Judgments rendered by Justices of the Peace; which was read, and referred to the committee on Judicial proceedings.

Also, the following bills:

A bill, entitled, an act to incorporate a company in Funk's Town, in Washington county, under the name of the Funks-Town Juvenile Librarian Society; which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Pigman, Page and Chapman.

A bill, entitled, a supplement to the act, entitled, an act to provide for electing commissioners for Allegany county, and prescribing their powers and duties, passed at December session, 1829, chapter 25; which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Pigman, Sappington and Page.

A bill, entitled, an act for the relief of the heirs and representatives of the late Nicholas Snowden; which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Wootton, Mayer and Dennis.

Mr. Mayer, presented the memorial of the Maryland State Colonization Society; which was read, and referred to Messrs. Mayer, Emory and Sappington.
