

In the 2d line of the resolution strike out the words "levy court" and insert "the commissioners for."

In the 14th line after the word "slave" insert the words "for a term of years."

The resolution was then assented to and returned to the house of delegates.

On motion of Mr. Pigman, leave was granted to bring in a bill, to be entitled, A supplement to an act, entitled, A further supplement to an act to establish a bank and incorporate a company under the name of the Cumberland Bank of Allegany.

Ordered, That Messrs. Pigman, Claude and Dennis be a committee to prepare and report the same.

Mr. Mayer from the committee on judicial proceedings, to which was referred the bill, entitled, An act for the sale of real estate therein mentioned, reported that the committee had had said bill under consideration, and were of opinion it ought not to pass.

It was read the second, and by special order the third time, rejected, and returned to the house of delegates.

Mr. Mayer submitted the following report, which was read and concurred in:

The committee to which was referred the petition of S. Sterett and others, praying the grant of a lottery for erecting a monument to the memory of Thomas Jefferson, reports:

That while they applaud the patriotic sentiment in which the application in question originated, your committee cannot but consider it inexpedient to grant the request, as to do so would violate the policy, and interfere with the system, as to lotteries, which for salutary purposes have been adopted by the state.

They would, therefore, propose that the petitioners have leave to withdraw their petition.

Mr. Claude from the committee to which was referred the bill, entitled, An act for the extension and renewal of the charter of the Farmers Bank of Maryland and branches, and for other purposes, reported favorably thereon.
