

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Mayer, Morris and Pigman.

A bill entitled, an act to divorce Elizabeth Ringgold of the city of Baltimore, from her husband Perry Ringgold;

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on divorces.

A bill entitled, an act for the appointment of a Trustee for the sale of certain real estate therein mentioned;

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on judicial proceedings.

And, returned the resolution relative to the Washington Monument;

Endorsed, "assented to."

Also, returned the bill which originated in the senate; entitled, a supplement to the act entitled, an act to incorporate the Annapolis Savings Fund, passed December session 1832, chapter 30, endorsed, "will pass."

Also returned the bill which originated in the senate, entitled, a farther supplement to the act entitled, an act incorporating a company for the improvement of the public road from the city of Frederick to Harper's Ferry, passed at December session 1828, chapter 142, endorsed "will pass," with the proposed amendments:

Which amendments were read and adopted, and were as follows:

Insert after the word "the" near the end of the 2d line in the 1st section the words "Frederick and."

Also returned the bill which originated in the senate, entitled, an act to repeal an act for the establishment and support of public free schools in the first election district of Baltimore county, and the several supplements thereto, endorsed, "will pass with the proposed amendments."

Which amendments were read and were as follows:

In the 4th line 2d section before the word "have" insert the words "or shall" and in the same line after the word "law" insert the words "prior to the first Monday of October next."
