MARYLAND:—To WIT:

At a Session of the General Assembly of Maryland, begun and held in the City of Annapolis, on the last Monday in December, being the twenty-ninth day of the month, in the year one thousand eight hundred and thirty-four, the following Senators appeared in the Senate Chamber, and took their seats:—Dennis Claude, Thomas Emory, William Hughlett, James Montgomery, John B. Morris, Henry Page, Thomas Sappington, Henry P. C. Wilson and William T. Wootton, Esquires.

On motion of Mr. Claude,

The senate proceeded to the election of a President.

On motion of Mr. Hughlett, Mr. Forrest was put in nomination.

The ballot box was prepared, and the ballots deposited therein, and on examination thereof by the clerk, it appeared there had been nine votes given, all of which were for Mr. Forrest.
