After the word "if" in the same line, insert "found."

Mr. Mayer from the committee to which was referred the petition of John and Emily McTavish, reported a bill entitled, an act for the benefit of John McTavish.

Which was read the first time.

Mr. Mayer from committee on judicial proceedings, to which the leave was granted, reported a bill entitled, an act relating to proceedings in equity.

Which was read the first time.

Mr. Wilson from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, a supplement to an act entitled, an act for the building a public bridge over Birch Branch in Worcester county, reported that the committee had had said bill under consideration, and were of opinion it ought to pass with the following amendment,

Which was read and assented to:

Amend the title of the bill by inserting between "act" and "entitled" the words "passed at the present session."

The bill was then read the second, and by special order the third time, passed, and returned to the House of Delegates.

Mr. Mayer from the committee to which was referred the bill entitled, a further additional supplement to an act to regulate the inspection of lumber in the city of Baltimore, reported favorably thereon.

It was read the second time.

Mr. Montgomery from the committee to which the leave was granted, reported a bill entitled, a further supplement to an act entitled, an act vesting certain powers in the President of the United States.

Which was read the first, and by special order the second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The bill entitled, an act for the benefit of John McTavish,

Mr. Pigman from the committee on insolvency, to which was referred the bill entitled, an act for the relief of James B. Collins of Caroline county, reported favorably thereon.
