

The clerk of the House of Delegates delivered the following bills:

An act to authorise the Governor and Council to appoint inspectors of lime and charcoal in the city of Baltimore,

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Pigman, Morris and Wilson.

A bill entitled, an act to authorise the leasing of land situated in Baltimore county, in which Henry Payson Norris is interested,

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on judicial proceedings.

And returned the following bills which originated in the Senate severally endorsed, "will pass."

The bill entitled, an act to authorise an exchange of certain grounds therein mentioned.

The bill entitled, a supplement to an act for amending and reducing into system, the laws and regulations concerning last wills and testaments, the duties of executors, administrators and guardians and the rights of orphans, and other representatives of deceased persons.

Also returned the following bills which originated in the senate, severally endorsed, "Will not pass"

The bill entitled, a further supplement to an act entitled, an act for the relief of creditors, and to prevent frauds and deceits occasioned by secret sales, mortgages and gifts of goods and chattels,

The bill entitled, a supplement to the act, entitled, an act for limitations of certain actions and for avoiding suits at law.

The bill entitled, an act relating to licenses for the sale of spirituous liquors.

The bill entitled a further supplement to the act entitled, an act directing the manner of suing out attachments in this province and limiting the extent of them.

On motion of Mr. Pigman,

Leave was granted to Messrs. Pigman, Mayer and Forrest, to prepare and report a bill to be entitled, an act to limit the operation and effect of mortgages and for other purposes.

Mr. Forrest from the committee on pensions to which was referred the bill entitled, an act relating to county pensioners, reported that the committee had had said bill under consideration and were of opinion it ought not to pass
