Which was read the first time, and referred to the committee on finance.

A bill entitled, A further supplement to an act to provide for the distribution of that part of the school fund which is appropriated to Baltimore county, passed at December session, 1828, chapter 185,

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Mayer, Morris and Pigman.

A bill entitled, An act to preserve the fish, oysters, and terrapins, in Wye River,

Which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Hughlett, Emory and Mayer.

A bill entitled, An act to regulate the manner of obtaining and altering public roads in this State,

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on judicial proceedings.

And returned the bill which originated in the Senate, entitled, A further supplement to the act entitled, an act relating to insolvent debtors in the county and city of Baltimore, endorsed "will pass, with the proposed amendments,"

Which amendments were read and adopted,
