

The following amendment was read and assented to: Strike out the name "Alexander Mackenzie," wherever it occurs in the title and the bill.

It was then read through, passed, and returned to the House of Delegates.

The bill entitled, A supplement to an act entitled, an act relating to the records of conveyances in the several counties of the State, passed at December session, 1833, chapter 88;

The bill entitled, An act to prevent the useless accumulation of costs arising from the publication of notices of orders, passed by the courts or judges thereof, in such counties wherein no newspapers are edited, reported favorably thereon;
